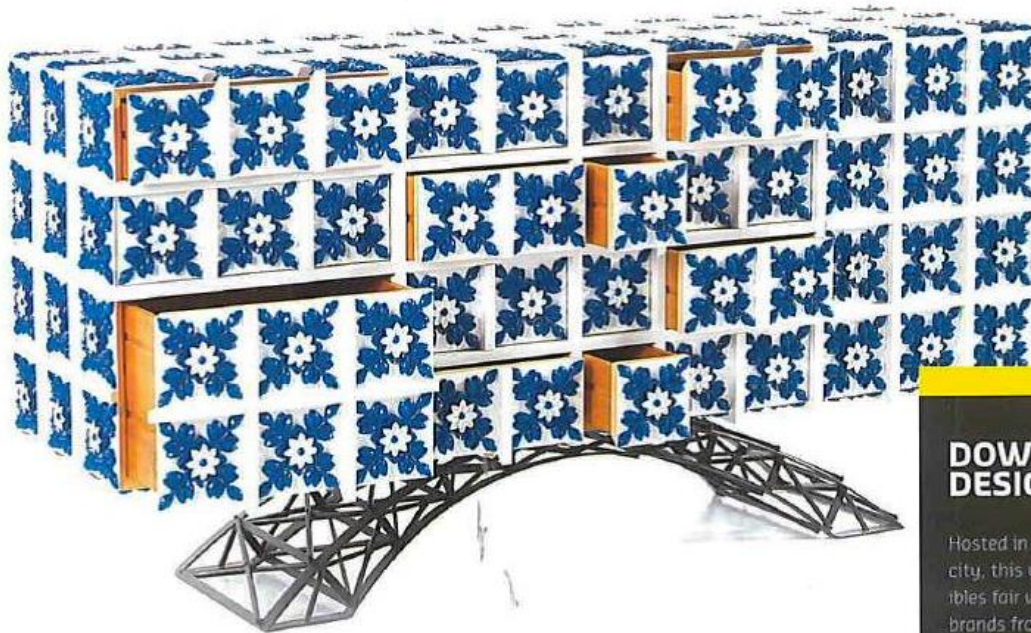

DOWNTOWN DESIGN

Hosted in d3, the creative heart of the city, this year's edition of the collectibles fair will bring together over 100 brands from 28 countries. Downtown Design (October 25-28) will also host design weeks from five cities: Addis Ababa, Barcelona, Beirut, Reykjavik and Taiwan.

Exhibitors for the upcoming edition of Downtown Design include new debutant regional brands such as Green Road and Pallavi Dean from the UAE and Samovar Carpets from Kuwait; internationally Kettal, Sancal, Swarovski, Bernhardt and Siematic will exhibit for the first time and iconic international brands such as Moroso, Georg Jensen, Gaggenau and Arclinea will return after last year's successful fair.
